Sesfontein Guesthouse is situated right at the heart of the village of Sesfontein, about 110 km north of Palmwag. Staying at Sesfontein Guesthouse is a very rural experience with donkey carts a common sight and being woken up by crowing chickens well before dawn

THE ROOMS

We offer 10 rooms each furnished with 1 double bed with the possibility of adding 1 extra single bed.

All rooms come complete with en-suite bathroom, air-conditioning and mosquito nets. The guesthouse offers a swimming pool and provides secure parking.

MORNING HIMBA VILLAGE VISIT

Min. 2 Pax

We depart in a guesthouse 4x4 safari vehicle (if available) or your 4x4 vehicle to a Himba village. Here you will be able to see the daily duties in the village. Himba people are very proud of their tradition and they will explain their daily life to you. You will also have the possibility to view the accommodation and living areas.

Duration: 4 hours

Includes: food presents for Himbas and water

for guests.

AFTERNOON HOANIB ELEPHANT DRIVE (INCLUDING AM HIMBA VILLAGE VISIT)

Min. 2 Pax



This excursion is a full-day excursion: a visit to a Himba village in the morning and an afternoon excursion into the dry Hoanib riverbed.

After an early breakfast, we depart from the guesthouse and drive to a Himba village, where we meet some of the Himba people. Here you will be able to see the daily duties in the village. Himba people are very proud of their tradition and they will explain their daily life to you. You will also have the possibility to view the accommodation and living areas.

Afterwards, we explore parts of the Hoanib River in search of the elusive desert-adapted elephants (wildlife sightings are never a guarantee).

Includes: light lunch and refreshment drinks.

Requires a min. 2-night stay at the guesthouse on a DBB basis (at an additional cost).

SUNDOWNER DRIVE

We depart on a scenic nature drive in a 4x4 safari vehicle to a nearby lookout point/sunset spot. Here we relax and enjoy the breathtaking views with some snacks and drinks.

Duration: 2.5-3 hours (16:00/17:00-

19:00/19:30).

Includes: snacks and sundowner drinks.





SLEEP-OUT PACKAGES

Accommodation for our guests is provided in modern dome style tents. The tents provide comfortable beds consisting of a stretcher, a fully made up bedroll, a blanket and a pillow.

When it does decide to get chilly, especially during wintertime, we supply extra blankets for our guests' ultimate comfort.

We provide basic communal ablutions and ensure privacy as well as comfort in the wildest of locations. Descriptions are only guidelines. Actual logistics at the discretion of the guide. Subject to weather conditions and animal movements.

DUNES OR ROCKS STANDARD SLEEP-OUT PACKAGE

- 1 night sleep-out [DBB]
- Drinks are not included
- Min. 2 pax
- On day of arrival, quests to arrive at the questhouse no later than 14:00.

The adventure starts as a sundowner drive in the late afternoon.

After the sundowner, the clients will be taken to the camp which has been set up prior to their arrival. The camp will be set up either near the dunes (depending on the wind) or the rocks.

Later in the evening, a warm dinner will be prepared on the fire. After dinner, the guests can enjoy sitting around the fire, listening to the sounds of the wild and gazing at the stars above.

As dawn breaks, the day begins with hot filter coffee/tea and rusks around the fire. The guests will then be transferred back to the guesthouse in time for a shower and scrumptious breakfast before they depart for their next destination.

ELEPHANT DRIVE & SLEEP-OUT PACKAGE (INCLUDING HIMBA VILLAGE VISIT)

- 1 night sleep-out [DBB] and 1 night Sesfontein Guesthouse [FB] (or vice versa, at our discretion)
- 1x Himba village visit
- 1x Hoanib elephant excursion

After breakfast we head due north and start our adventure with a visit to a Himba village. Here you will be able to see the daily duties in the village. Himba people are very proud of their tradition and they will explain their daily life to you. You will also have the possibility to view the accommodation and living areas.

We make our way into the Hoanib and enjoy lunch under some large shaded tree.

Afterwards, we explore parts of the Hoanib River in search of the elusive desert-adapted elephants (wildlife sightings are never a guarantee). With some luck we could spot some lion and even rhino.

In the late afternoon, a suitable spot will be found to pitch the camp. While guests enjoy the surroundings and a sundowner, the staff will put up the tents and prepare the food. The guests can enjoy their evening out in the wild whilst sitting around the fire. A warm dinner will be prepared on the fire.

After dinner, the guests can enjoy sitting around the fire, listening to the sounds of the wild and gazing at the stars above.

After an early-morning tea/coffee with rusks we pack up and make our way back to Sesfontein. On arrival you enjoy a proper full late breakfast after which you depart for your next destination.

NB - the above can also be done the other way around. We start with the sleep-out on day of arrival. Then do the Himba visit the next morning and back to Sesfontein Guesthouse for lunch. It all depends on what works best logistically, the time of year, temperatures and guests' wishes.



RHINO TRACKING & Sleep-out package

- 1 night Sesfontein Guesthouse [DBB]
- 1 night sleep-out [FB]
- 1 night Sesfontein Guesthouse [DBB]
- 1x full-day rhino tracking
- Drinks are not included
- Min. 2 pax

After arriving at the guesthouse, the guests can spend the rest of the afternoon at leisure. A warm dinner will be prepared at the guesthouse.

After an early breakfast, we depart from the guesthouse. We explore parts of the Hoanib River (where you might see some elephants, although wildlife sightings are never a guarantee) and the Kaokoveld plains in search of the elusive black rhino, driving all the way to the Huncab area. We work closely with the "Save The Rhino Trust" making use of specialised trackers from the Sesfontein conservancy. We spend a full day tracking the endangered black rhino. Longer walks on foot might be necessary in order to get close to these elusive animals. This is not a guaranteed sighting or "soft" adventure. The terrain can be rough and challenging and a lot of physical effort might be required to get close to a rhino.

In the late afternoon, we find a suitable spot to pitch the camp. While the guests enjoy the surroundings and a sundowner, the staff will put up the tents and prepare the food. A warm dinner will be prepared on the fire.

After dinner, the guests can enjoy sitting around the fire, listening to the sounds of the wild and gazing at the stars above.

After an early breakfast, we spend the morning exploring the Huncab area before driving back through the Hoanib River. The guests will then be transferred back to the guesthouse before dinner. A warm dinner will be prepared at the guesthouse.

In the morning, the guests enjoy a scrumptious breakfast before they depart for their next destination.

RESERVATIONS & CANCELLATION

All reservations must be confirmed in writing, and by provision of a final rooming list, not less than 60 days prior to arrival.
